Communion Class at The Dover Church

We are offering a communion class for 2nd - 4th graders to learn about what communion means, and to celebrate them as they step into a new phase of life and engagement in the church!

Our communion class will meet on Sunday from 5-6:30 during Lent (3/9, 3/16, 3/23, 3/30, and 4/6). Through games and hands-on activities, we will learn about the meaning of communion. We'll act out Bible Stories, do crafts, and make bread and grape juice from scratch. While children will still be welcome at the communion table before/without completing this course, we hope that this course will deepen and enrich the communion experience, as well as strengthen connections between our children and their church peers, their church community, and their faith! We also hope this class provides a faith formation opportunity for families for whom Sunday School is difficult to attend due to other commitments. The experience will culminate on Palm Sunday, April 13th. As part of the service (already a fun one with a palm parade!) we will celebrate the class by inviting them forward at communion time to recognize their learning and their role in our congregation. Family and friends are encouraged to be there! We plan to offer this class every other year so that we have a robust group. We will only meet five times, so attendance is very important!
